Registration & Sign-in Sunday Sept. 11th "Kick-Off" Saturday Sept. 17th



Welcome! This fall your Pre-K or Kindergartener is eligible to participate in the RSA KinderKickers & Squirts soccer programs.

The KinderKickers program is unique to Ramsey and is designed to give each child an opportunity to have fun, develop friendships, a sense of sportsmanship and fair play, all while learning the game of soccer. The Squirts program is a slightly scaled back version of Kinderkickers. We would like to invite you and your child to join us this fall for some fun, sun and fresh air while the kids learn how to play the world's most popular game.

KinderKickers is a clinic-based program in which the parents become the coaches. We will introduce the kids to playing soccer and the parents to coaching. Ramsey Soccer is staffed completely by volunteers and this is a great, safe environment for <u>moms</u> and <u>dads</u> to get their first experience helping the kids play soccer. Don't worry, no soccer or coaching experience is required! If you are good with kids, we will teach you all that you need to know. Kinderkickers has been designed with this purpose in mind:

All parents interested in being a facilitator/coach <u>must</u> attend a pre-KinderKickers training session, hosted by RSA and run by professional trainers! The session will begin at 2:30 on Sept 17th on the Smith School Field.

The Kinderkickers program runs 6 consecutive weeks from Sept. 17th through Oct. 22th with our KK WORLD CUP day Oct. 22nd. We will utilize a "Games Based Play" format. All of the children will be involved in activities with a soccer ball that help them learn soccer by playing fun games like "Red light/Green light". Each session is concluded with our co-ed groups playing four against four on a mini-field. The program will be completely NON-COMPETITIVE. We will not keep score and fans are expected to cheer and positively reenforce all players on the field.

Teams are not formal in the clinic. We encourage families and friends to share in this soccer experience, understanding that a few familiar faces are sometimes critical to early success!
