HUBBARD SCHOOL'S HALLOWEEN PARADE Monday, October 31st at 2:20pm

- The students will parade through the school to show off their costumes to their fellow students, then walk around the building to show off their costumes to parents and adults. All parents and adults should wait OUTSIDE of Hubbard.
- Students will parade out the main entrance of the school, turn left and walk around the exterior of the building, towards the gym, to the back playgrounds. Please spread out completely around the building so the children can be celebrated during the entire parade. **Some of the best places to see the parade are the side of building and the back playground areas.** Please stand on the grass, not on the walkway or sidewalk because the students will need the room for the parade.
- **Dismissal will occur immediately after the parade – please go immediately to your child's dismissal exit following the parade.**
- All AM Kindergarteners and Preschoolers are invited to participate in the parade. Please bring your child to the main entrance at 2:00pm and a staff member will escort your child to their classroom. They will dismiss at their normal dismissal area immediately after the parade.
- Parking is an issue at Hubbard. Most spots are used by staff members. Both of our traffic circles need to be kept clear, and you are not allowed to park along the inner side of either circle. You will need to park on a side street and walk to the parade.
- A note about costumes: Please make sure your child will be able to see clearly and is able to navigate stairs while in their costumes. Please do not send any weapons to school as costume accessories. We appreciate your cooperation as student safety is our top priority.
- If it happens to rain on October 31st, this event will be held for the students only within the building. It will include an inside parade and classroom activities. No parents will be allowed to participate.
